Year 3/4 Easter Performance










What a match! A huge congratulations to our Year 3/4 football team for their outstanding performance on the pitch.

We're incredibly proud of each and every player. Well done, and best of luck for the next match!












Parents Evening

All of this could not be achieved without the support of our parents, guardians and friends of Thursfield.












